

How Do I Register My Child?

- Registration packets are available at each school site.
- **Proof of residency** (i.e. utility bill, PG&E bill), your **child's birth certificate**, and current **immunization record** are required to register your child.
- Once completed, registration packets may be mailed or hand delivered to the Dry Creek Joint Elementary School District Office - 9707 Cook Riolo Road, Roseville, CA 95747.
- Enrollment will be on a first come, first served basis. Each registration packet is checked for completion and will be date stamped upon verification.

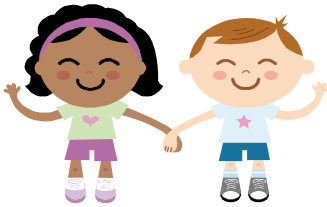

What is Transitional Kindergarten?

Do you feel your child is not quite ready for kindergarten due to social behaviors, academics, or simply age? If so, Transitional Kindergarten might be the perfect fit for your child! Transitional Kindergarten, "TK", is a program designed for students who may benefit from an extra year of learning before entering a traditional kindergarten class. It is for those "younger" students that need something more than what preschool offers, but are not quite ready for kindergarten.

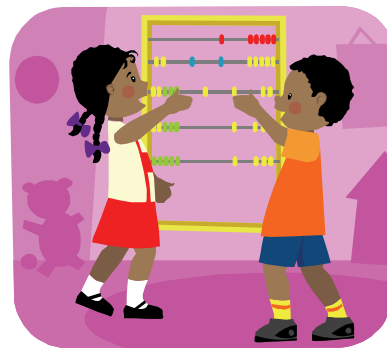
Age Requirements

If your child turns five years old on or before **December 2, 2012**, he/she is eligible for the TK program.

Our Program

TK teachers are fully credentialed and will utilize a transitional kindergarten curriculum aligned with the California State Content Standards. Kindergarten readiness is the primary goal of the TK program, which focuses on language and literacy activities as well as early math skills.

There is a strong emphasis on social, emotional, and motor skill development. Students have the opportunity for "hands on" learning through exploration and inquiry. They will have many opportunities to build confidence, which lays a foundation for school success in years to come!

Things to Know

- First day of class begins on August 8, 2012.
- TK will start and end at the same time as AM kindergarten, and will follow the district calendar.
- Transportation will be the responsibility of parent or caregiver.
- Class size depends on enrollment, but will not exceed 24 students.
- Program location will be determined prior to the beginning of school.
- TK students are required to enroll in a traditional kindergarten class at their home school for the 2013-2014 school year.
